

Clear Round

4pm to 5.30pm Strictly last entry at 5pm- £5

Height 55cms, open to both horses and ponies, Lead rein/ Assistance allowed

All Classes £8

Horse and Pony

Class 1 to start 6pm

Class 1 Beginner – Single phase (max height 65cms in first section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not have won any money BSJA

Class 2 Novice – Single phase (max height 75cms in first section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £50 BSJA

Class 3 Intermediate –Single phase(max height 85cms in first section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £100 BSJA

Class 4 Advanced - Single phase (max height 95cms first section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £150 BSJA

Single Phase - Maximum of 12 fences split into two sections with the second section against the clock.

The competitor will jump the whole course unless they are eliminated.

The height in the second section will be set higher than those set in the first section.

Prize money given for 1st to 3rd places only: 1st - £10 / 2nd - £8 / 3rd - £6

In the event of insufficient entries prize money will be awarded at a ratio 1:5 (i.e. One prize for every 5 entries) Classes will not run if less than 5 entries

Points League

The point's league will operate at all of the above dates. 1st-6th will receive points 8-3 respectively with 2 point received by every competitor after. Points will be accumulated from September 2012 to July 2013 at both Sunday and Wednesday shows. The horse and rider combination that has gained the most points by the championship show 2012 will be announced the overall points winner (split into horse and pony) and will receive a trophy. Points are NOT awarded for the Clear Round.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Hats to current BSI standard must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.
2. **Appropriate competition dress should be worn by all competitors.**
3. Liability – the organisers or anyone acting on their behalf accept no liability whatsoever for loss injury, or damage to any animal, property, persons, or vehicle how so ever caused.
4. Objections must be handed in to the secretary in writing, within half an hour of the event, together with a deposit of £20. The deposit will be forfeited if the show officials decide the objection is not sustained.
5. The management reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving reason and to cancel alter the time of any class, also to run any class in another ring.
6. The management reserve the right to limit the entries in any class.
7. All prize money must be collected on the day of the show or they will be forfeited.
8. Competitors having entered a class are not entitled to a refund or to transfer any entries to another date once the class has started, should they decide to withdraw for any reason.
9. All unaffiliated show jumping competitions will be held under current BSJA Rules.
10. The judges, stewards, Myerscough College Staff and official helpers decision's are final.
11. Strictly no lungeing. Any horse/pony in the collecting ring must be in a bridle.
12. Horses should not be left unattended when tethered.
13. Children must be kept under close supervision at all times.
14. Ponies are considered 14.2hh and under and horses 14.3hh and over.
15. Anyone entering the pony classes must be 18years or under. Anyone over 18 must ride in the horse classes. (This is at the discretion of the show secretary) Horses may be ridden by juniors.
16. No excessive use of spurs (max length 3cm) or whips (max length 30cm) will be allowed.
17. Only competitors in the class taking place may use the practice fence.
18. DO NOT MUCK OUT boxes/trailers on the parking area.

Prize money given for 1st to 3rd places only: 1st - £10 / 2nd - £8 / 3rd - £6

In the event of insufficient entries prize money will be awarded at a ratio 1:5 (i.e. One prize for every 5 entries) Classes will not run if less than 5 entries

All Classes and warming up will be on prepared surfaces.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times
