Statement of Principles and Practice

For our residential students, living in the heart of a rural community, the objective translates to the provision of high quality accommodation, care and welfare for all throughout their time with us. We have a set of College values which are reviewed regularly and these are promoted together with British Values.

The objective is put into practice by a dedicated residential services team, who liaise with academic, support and management staff across the College to implement effective policies and procedures which ensure a residential environment that fosters learning, self development, esteem and respect for others.

The Learner Safeguarding and Prevent Team have a particular responsibility to ensure safeguarding and Prevent policies, procedures and practice are understood and followed by everyone.
