

Key Events & Experiences

Students are supported consider their next steps. This may involve applying for UCAS and developing a personal statement, and / or to create or update their CV. Students are supported through tutorials, careers workshops and 1:1 guidance meetings with a qualified Careers Adviser.

Students are invited to participate in the annual MyFuture EXPO event hosted at the Preston campus. This is an opportunity to speak directly to employers and to attend workshops and seminars delivered by representatives from a range of organisations. Foundation Learning students can also attend a Next Steps event held in Term 2 at Preston and Croxteth.

Students can work towards the BRONZE, SILVER and GOLD levels of the Myerscough Award, supporting students to develop career management skills and to create a portfolio of evidence to support the transition into work or higher education.

Work experience and voluntary work are an essential way to develop employability skills. Students are encouraged to develop networks and create opportunities with support from Job Coaches and the Careers Team to meet the requirements of their course and chosen career path.

Students are supported on their career journey by accessing a range of workshops and sessions delivery by the Careers Team and external providers at key points within their tutorial programme facilitated by Progress Coaches.
