Myerscough College's main campus is centrally situated in the heart of Lancashire, with great public transport links, wherever you're coming from, so you'll have no trouble in finding us!

### Road

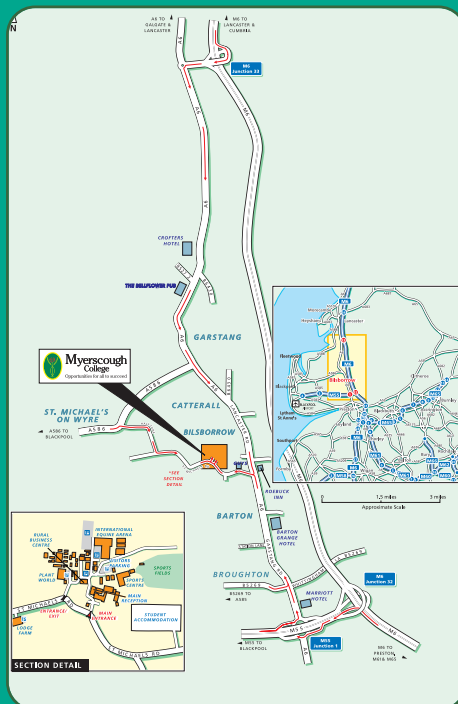
The College is just six miles north of Preston (or eight miles south of Lancaster), one mile from the main A6 Preston to Lancaster Road - which runs parallel to the M6. We're about 10 minutes from either Junction 32 of the M6 (Preston/Blackpool/M55) or Junction 33 (Lancaster South). You'll be glad to know that there's plenty of parking space for students on campus. For sat nav users our postcode is PR3 0RY, on St Michaels Road, Bilsborrow.

### Bus

Myerscough College provides transport to and from the main campus each weekday during term time. Our routes cover much of Lancashire including Blackpool (via Fleetwood and Poulton), Burnley (via Accrington and Blackburn), Clitheroe (via Longridge), St Annes (via Warton, Freckleton and Kirkham), Preston Bus Station and Preston Railway Station (both via Fulwood, Broughton and Barton). Annual passes are also available for Stagecoach service 125 (from Bolton, Horwich, Chorley and Bamber Bridge) to connect with the College service from Preston Bus Station and service 40/41 (from Lancaster and Morecambe) to Bilsborrow Village.

Our popular 'Number 80' bus service also runs during the day, between College and Preston Bus Station. An informative leaflet which details the bus routes, prices and connecting bus/train services is available to download from the College website.
