



## Ponies – Christmas Show

Sunday 17 December 2017 – 9am start

### Class 1 - Pony Intro 70cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

**Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £16.00, 3rd: £14.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £74.00**

**Entry Fee = £12.00**

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### Class 2 Pony British Novice Championship - First Round /80cm Open

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

British Novice: For registered ponies in Grade JD and JC that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

80cm Open: For registered ponies to be ridden by Junior Members.

If combined with an open: In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

**Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £86.00**

**Entry Fee = £14.00**

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### Class 3 - Pony Discovery -First Round/90cm Open

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

Discovery: For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open: For registered ponies, to be ridden by Junior Members.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

**Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00**

**Entry Fee = £14.00**

## Class 4 - not before 12:00 - Springboard 128/138cm Handicap

Rule 415. Table A (2 Round). Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 90cm / 1.00m.

Table A. Two Rounds not against the clock. All equal first in Round One will go forward to Round Two over a shortened course.

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes: In the 128cms Section Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of Points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 10 years is reached. Riders who reach the age of 10 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 500 Points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination).

In the 138cms Section, Pony riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of Points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached. Riders who reach the age 12 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 850 Points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination).

Junior Riders are not eligible to enter the 138cms section until the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. 128cms Ponies are not permitted to enter the 138cms section.

Once riders have competed at, or have 'ever' qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final.

Pony/rider combinations who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the final of this competition.

Qualifies for: Springboard Final.

Qualifying Period: 1st August-31st January.

Numbers to Qualify: Two double clears to qualify for the Final. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. In order to compete in the Final, all qualified competitors ages must be in accordance with the Rule 77.12 & 77.13 in the year of the Final.

**Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £14.00, 5th: £14.00, Total: £88.00**

**Entry Fee = £14.00**

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## Class 5 - Winter 128cm First Round/Winter 138cm First Round

Rule 514 & 512. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.05m / 1.10m.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

**138cm Section:** For registered ponies that have won 30 Points or more exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms to be ridden by Pony or Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.12). Pony riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached.

Qualifies for: Winter 138cms Second Round Competition.

Qualifying period: September to January.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision).

**128cm Section:** For registered ponies that have won 30 Points or more not exceeding 128cms to be ridden by Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.13). Junior riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached.

Qualifies for: Winter 128cms Second Round Competition.

Qualifying period: September to January.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify (subject to revision).

Dispensation will be given to run the Winter 128cms and Winter 138cms First Rounds as a handicap competition. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. This class will split in the event of 20 starters or more and two sets of prize money awarded.

**Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £90.00**

**Entry Fee = £15.00**

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## Class 6 - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded.

Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final. Ponies may compete in one section only.

**Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £105.00**

**Entry Fee = £15.00**

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## Class 7 Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

**Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00, Total: £105.00**

**Entry Fee = £15.00**

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## Class 8 - Junior 1.15m & 1.25m Open Handicap

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.15m / 1.25m.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

**Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £40.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £163.00**

**Entry Fee = £18.00**

First Aid fee: £2 per competitor- medical cover in accordance with rule 73.8e

Entries confined to registered horses in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79. In event of insufficient entries prize money will be awarded in accordance with British Showjumping rule 76.6 and British Showjumping rule 82.20 applies

Junior members competing on horses are only able to do so from the beginning of the calendar year which the age of 12 years is reached.

1. Hats to current BSI standard must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.
2. **Appropriate competition dress should be worn by all competitors.**
3. Liability – the organisers or anyone acting on their behalf accept no liability whatsoever for loss injury, or damage to any animal, property, persons, or vehicle how so ever caused.
4. Objections must be handed in to the secretary in writing, within half an hour of the event, together with a deposit of £20. The deposit will be forfeited if the show officials decide the objection is not sustained.
5. The management reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving reason and to cancel alter the time of any class, also to run any class in another ring.
6. The management reserve the right to limit the entries in any class.
7. All prize money must be collected on the day of the show or they will be forfeited.
8. Competitors having entered a class are not entitled to a refund or to transfer any entries to another date once the class has started, should they decide to withdraw for any reason.
9. The judges, stewards, Myerscough College Staff and official helpers decision's are final.
10. Strictly no lungeing. Any horse/pony in the collecting ring must be in a bridle.
11. Horses should not be left unattended when tethered.
12. Children must be kept under close supervision at all times.
13. Only competitors in the class taking place may use the practice fence.
14. DO NOT MUCK OUT boxes/trailers on the parking area.
15. Allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any showjumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horse/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

All Classes will be in International Arena 80m x 30m , with warming up in Indoor Arena 65m x 21m.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, Refreshments available, Spectators Welcome
