Wednesday Clear Round Evenings 4.30pm – 8.00pm

Heights altered throughout the evening-starting at 55cms
(please note that the fences will not be lowered below 55cms)

£5 per round

Max time allowed 2 ½ min per round

Sept 18th, Oct 2nd, Nov 13th, Dec 18th, Jan 15th, Feb 26th

Wednesday Beginners Clear Round

Cross poles to a max height of 55cms, no fillers or spreads

4.30pm-6pm, riders 14yrs and under ONLY 6pm-8pm, open to all riders

£5 per round

Max time allowed 2 ½ min per round

Sept 25th, Oct 9th, Nov 27th, Jan 29th

Unaffiliated Showjumping

Sept 20th, Oct 4th, Dec 20th, Jan 3rd,

All Classes £10

Class 1 to start 6pm

Class 1 - 55cms - Single phase (max height 65cms in second section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not have won any money BS

Class 2 - 65cms - Single phase (max height 75cms in second section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £50 BS

Class 3 - 75cms - Single phase (max height 85cms in second section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £100 BS

Class 4 - 85cms - Single phase (max height 95cms second section)
Open to horse/pony and rider combination not to have won £150 BS

Prize money given for 1st to 3rd places only: 1st- £12 (8-11 entries)

2nd - £10 (12-15 entries), 3rd - £8 (16 + entries)

(Prize money awarded over all)

Single Phase - Maximum of 12 fences split into two sections with the second section against the clock.
The competitor will jump the whole course unless they are eliminated.
The height in the second section will be set higher than those set in the first section

Rules and Regulations:

1. Hats to current BSI standard must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.
2. **Appropriate competition dress should be worn by all competitors.**
3. Liability – the organisers or anyone acting on their behalf accept no liability whatsoever for loss injury, or damage to any animal, property, persons, or vehicle how so ever caused.
4. Objections must be handed in to the secretary in writing, within half an hour of the event, together with a deposit of £20. The deposit will be forfeited if the show officials decide the objection is not sustained.
5. The management reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving reason and to cancel alter the time of any class, also to run any class in another ring.
6. The management reserve the right to limit the entries in any class.
7. All prize money must be collected on the day of the show or they will be forfeited.
8. Competitors having entered a class are not entitled to a refund or to transfer any entries to another date once the class has started, should they decide to withdraw for any reason.
9. All unaffiliated show jumping competitions will be held under current BSJA Rules.
10. The judges, stewards, Myerscough College Staff and official helper's decision is final.
11. Strictly no lunging. Any horse/pony in the collecting ring must be in a bridle.
12. Horses should not be left unattended when tethered.
13. Children must be kept under close supervision at all times.
14. Ponies are considered 14.2hh and under and horses 14.3hh and over.
15. Anyone entering the pony classes must be 18years or under. Anyone over 18 must ride in the horse classes. (This is at the discretion of the show secretary) Horses may be ridden by juniors.
16. No excessive use of spurs (max length 3cm) or whips to be between 45cm & 75cm will be allowed.
17. Only competitors in the class taking place may use the practice fence.
18. DO NOT MUCK OUT boxes/trailers on the parking area.

All Classes and warming up will be on prepared surfaces, Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, Refreshments available, Spectators welcome
