Strong boots essential for outdoor work but sensible, non-slip shoes will be required for indoor work. Plimsoll shoes that enclose the whole foot e.g. lace-ups or elasticated are acceptable. Ballet pumps or ballet -type flat shoes are not acceptable and will not be allowed for indoor work on the Animal unit. No earrings / studs / nose / eye rings or visible body piercings are permitted whilst students undertaking practical sessions. This is for student and animal safety and is strictly enforced. Nail extensions can cause serious injury if ripped and are not allowed. Any student not complying with the above will not be allowed to undertake practical work or work with animals
